5. Exhibits are to be brought in between 9am and 11am on the day.
6. Entry is 50p per exhibit.
7. Judges' decisions are final, they may withhold prizes if they see fit.
8. No responsibility is accepted for items left after the show.
9. Exhibits not for sale must be clearly marked.
10. Children under 15 are welcome to enter the adult classes but they must have grown or made the entries themselves.
