## A message from the head teacher...

Dear parents, firstly thanks for all who attended the FOLS bingo on Saturday, I am sorry I couldn't attend, I had a sick baby and partner to attend to. I hope it was fun and we raised a solid £227—which is great. Thanks, as ever, to the FOLS volunteers who give up their time to help organise these events, we really appreciate what you do.

It was a typically busy week in school last week and all children were happy and engaged in their learning. Our new phonics scheme devised by Twinkl is really progressing and thank you for all your support at home, the children are making so much progress and that is in no small part down to you.

Reading with your child every night is crucial, studies show that children who read every night for 20 minutes score in the 90th percentile for attainment, so we can see it has a huge impact on academic success in school.

Attendance was 94% for last week which was up 2% from the previous week but is still below 96%. Good attendance (like reading every day) has a huge impact on success in school and engenders good habits for life so making sure your child is here everyday and on time is really important. Thanks for all you are doing to support your child's attendance.


