As you may have seen via e-mail on Friday, I shared our most recent Ofsted report with you. We were judged 'good' in all areas but please see below for some highlights. Finally, thank you to all parents who answered the parent survey.



- The school has high expectations for pupils' learning and behaviour.
- The whole school community plays an important role in expanding the opportunities on offer. Pupils celebrate their achievements in the parish church, often with members of their family present to share their successes.
- Pupils love their school and have a strong sense of belonging.
- The school has designed a curriculum that fits its pupils' needs well.
- Relationships between pupils and staff are warm and respectful. This helps all pupils meet the school's high expectations of behaviour
- The school rightly recognises the need to broaden pupils' horizons and is embedding greater diversity across the curriculum, taking pupils 'beyond the village'.
