Members of the 100 Club can buy one or more numbers per year at a cost of £12 per number. **The more numbers you have, the greater your chance of winning!**

PRIZES

There will be one draw each month for **3 cash prizes** funded by the income from the 100 Club. Between January and November the prizes will be divided between 3 lucky winners as follows:

The Friends of Lewknor School – 100 Club Rules

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The promoter of the 100 Club is The Friends of Lewknor School (FoLS), charity registration number 1045910. 2. The object of the 100 Club is to raise funds for Lewknor Church of England Primary School. 3. The 100 Club will be run under the supervision of the FoLS Committee who will also administer the Club. 4. The 100 Club is open to all Members of FoLS, which the FoLS constitution defines as: <u>Family Members</u> Parents or guardians of all pupils attending the school, and; <u>Other Members</u> Teachers, Past Parents, Grandparents, Friends of the school, Ancillary staff and Governors. 5. Members must be aged 18 or over to participate in the 100 Club. 6. Members must complete and return an application form and will then be allocated a number(s). 7. Entry to the 100 Club will be by subscription for a 12-month period commencing in November of each year. The cost shall be £1 per month per number, payable in advance. Members may request a number part way through a 12-month period and will be charged pro-rata and entered into the next available draw following payment. 8. Members will not be able to opt in or out of the 100 Club on a month by month basis. 9. Unless otherwise advised, a Member will be deemed to have left the Club if their renewal of subscription remains unpaid for a period of one month. Members wishing to leave the 100 Club may do so at the end of the annual subscription period. Refunds will not be given for Members wishing to withdraw before the end of the current subscription period. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 10. Members may hold more than one number. 11. Prize draws will be held monthly and overseen by the Headteacher, Chair of Governors or a suitable deputy appointed by the FoLS Committee. 12. Winners will be contacted personally and the names of all winners will be published in the School newsletter and displayed on the School noticeboard each month following the draw. 13. The annual prize fund will comprise approximately 54% of the annual income (assuming 100 numbers are sold). 14. Prize money is confirmed on the application form (overleaf). The structure of the prize fund including the size, frequency and number of draws or prizes may be amended by the FoLS Committee at the commencement of each subscription period and shall be communicated to Members accordingly. 15. A register will be kept recording the name and address of each Member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received. 16. If a prize winner cannot be contacted or has not claimed a prize within 6-months of the date of the prize draw, then the winnings shall be forfeited and placed into FoLS funds. 17. The decision of FoLS Committee shall be final in all matters requiring adjudication. 18. The FoLS Committee shall have the power to amend or revoke these rules or wind-up the 100 Club at their absolute discretion with such reasonable notice to the 100 Club Members as is deemed necessary.
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
