Sophie is pictured left, with her medal, after her team came third in the annual Aspire Team Squash Championships. Sophie, who is the youngest in the team, plays for the south of England. Eight teams took part in the regional championship tournament, which was held at three clubs in Warwickshire — Kenilworth, Leamington and Warwick University.

Sophie was 9th in the whole country when she recently finished her Under-11 season. She came 12th at the English Championships last August, 14th in the British Championships in January and is now working her way up the rankings in Under-13s, having entered in at 28th place out of 93. She has two singles matches left this season and a new season starts in September / October when Sophie will be competing once again in the British Championships.
